- (b) Jesus is condemned to death. Ecce Homo.

(a) Volume 5, October 12, 1903, Page 28, (whole chapter) The crowning contains many meanings. Volume 7, March 5, 1906, Page 7 (whole chapter) Jesus's thorns penetreated into His mouth. He wanted to suffer this for human pride. Volume 7, September 23, 1906, Page 47, (whole chapter) Jesus tells Luisa the Blood from the crowning was shed for love. Volume 7, November 9, 1906, Page 66 (whole chapter) Souls who meditate on Jesus's Passion Crown Him with glory. Volume 1, Page 53, (whole chapter) Luisa as victim, participates in the sufferings of Jesus by being crowned with thorns. She makes reparation for sin especially pride. (b) Volume 19, June 20, 1926, Pages 55and 56 Ecce Homo. How Jesus felt as many deaths for as many that cried "CRUCIFY HIM." All cried, "CRUCIFY HIM, CRUCIFY HIM". Not only all that were present, but all the absent past and future. And if someone did not say it with words, He said it with deeds, because there was not a single one who wanted Jesus alive. Others confirmed it with silence. This cry of death was the most sorrowful for Jesus. He felt himself crowned in pains and deaths, much more because He saw that each death did not carry life to each one. (Paraphrased from Volume 16).
