- In Mary's kiss to Jesus' Bloody and bruised Lips.
- In Mary's kiss to Jesus' hands.
- In all the wounds of Jesus as Mary encloses all souls
- Into these wounds as She put back the pieces of flesh that hung from His Body.
- In Mary's Act of Kissing Jesus' poor feet where the weight of His Body ripped them.
- In the Act of Mary when She buries Jesus and the rock closes the tomb.
