- In the fulfillment of the prayer of Jesus and of the whole Church, "Your Kingdom come and your Will be done on earth as It is in Heaven."
- 4 In the rainbow of peace that will be formed after the deluge of sin comes to an end
- In the unification of Heaven and earth
