Symbolism of the Number Forty and Forty Days in the Desert

The number forty is symbolic and significant in the Life of Jesus on earth. When He was born He wanted to remain in the grotto of Bethlehem for forty days –symbol of the Divine Will, while being present in the midst of creatures, He was as though hidden and outside of the city of their souls. Jesus, wanting to repair for the forty centuries of the human will, wanted to remain outside the city for forty days, crying and moaning to call back the Divine Will into the city of souls.
