SCRIPTURE REFERENCES FOR THIS LESSON

This is the most common topic in the Bible.

For example: the Covenants God made with Adam, Abraham, Moses and Christ. All of these had the purpose of establishing a committed relationship between God and His creature Man.

There are so many references it would require a book!

Look at :

- a) The Incarnation, life, Passion and Death of the Son of God....
- b) The Mystery of the Indwelling of the Trinity in us.
- c) Holy Communion etc.
- d) The bible is full of promises from God which say “I will be with you...”: Mt 28:20
- e) The Book of Isaiah (just to take one example) is literally full of promises that “your God is coming!”
- f) Look at God “walking with Adam in the cool of the day” in Genesis 3
- g) Look at the Blessed Trinity visiting Abraham in Genesis 18
