- **4** In all Creation, that felt the force of the love of Jesus' Creative Power renewed in them
- In the true honor that man feels because the One who created them needed them to care for His Humanity
- 4 In the light and heat of the sun that recognized its Creator
- 4 In the honor of the earth when it felt its Creator lying in a manger
- In the water that wanted to quench Jesus' thirst
- 4 In the birds that wanted to sing their trills and warbles to amuse Baby Jesus
- ↓ In all creation that wanted to give their innocent tributes
- 4 In the shepherds who came to adore our Lord

- In the third way that Jesus is born in the soul by the three loves: heroic love, ever-increasing love, and love of sacrifice.
