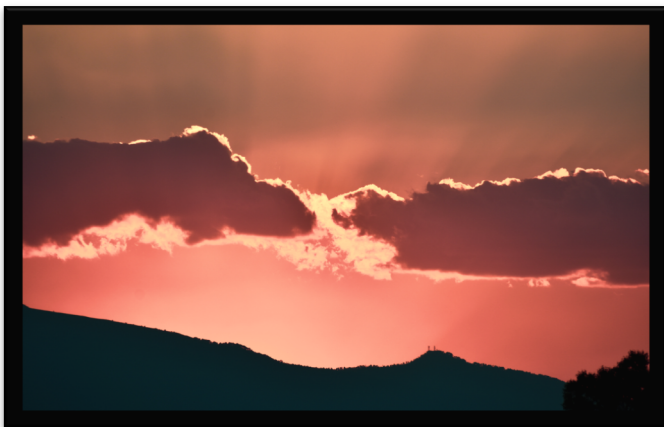
- ✚ In the Divine Will that can be found everywhere

- ✚ In the instant that the soul removes her own will, she flows in Jesus and He in her
- ✚ In the wonder that all of God's goods are at her disposal: power, light, assistance, and everything she desires
- ✚ In the desire of the soul to live in the Divine Will
- ✚ In the Will of God that assumes all the work, gives the soul what she lacks, and makes her expand into all the limitless boundaries of God's Will

- ✚ In death to the exterior senses
- ✚ In the holy fear of God which is the guardian and will safeguard the house
- ✚ In the desire to do everything to please God

- For all the offenses to the Holy Eucharist
