- For those who refuse to carry their crosses with resignation – instead they rage, curse, murder, and commit suicide
- For those who sin through ignorance, frailty, and weakness
- For all morally risky encounters, for those who expose themselves needlessly to occasions of sin, and for those who expose themselves out of necessity and fall into sin
- For our repeated falls into sin and for the grave sins committed by every class of people
- For hidden sins which have not been satisfied for – concealed sins which increase the bitterness of Jesus’ torments
- For all the sins of consecrated souls
