- ✚ In Divine Will souls, who will be the crown of God

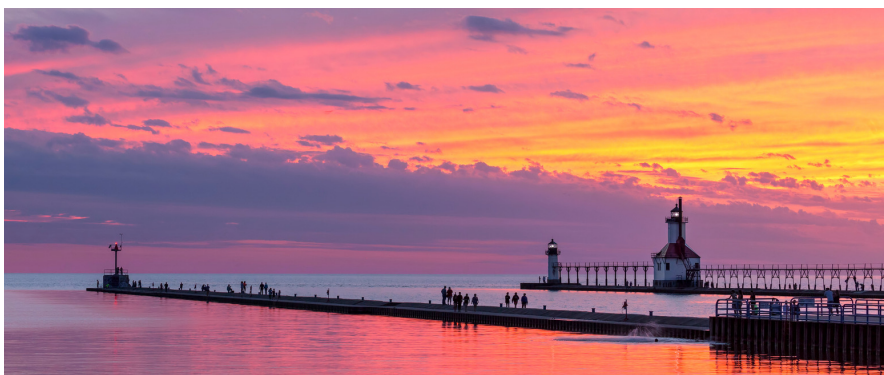
