stray from the Shepherd and the flock.

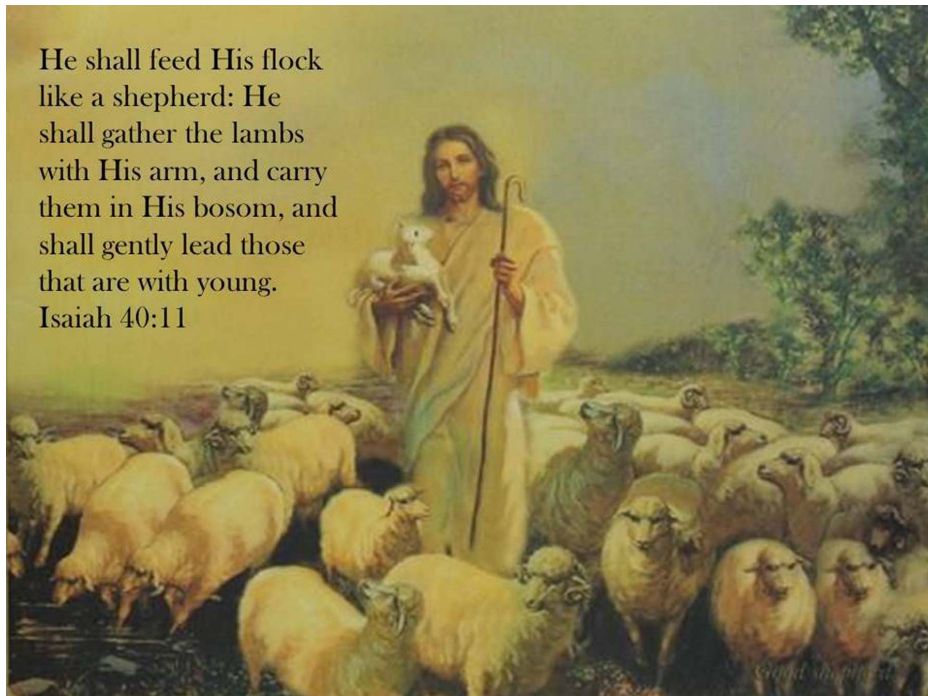
Volume 12, November 27, 1917, Page 44, (whole chapter)
