Jesus taught Luisa the way to receive Communion – that is united with His Humanity, His Divinity and His Will.

Jesus takes the office of Priest and consecrates souls.

Rounds

- In the Divine Will which is perennial Communion.
- In the Words spoken by Jesus at the Consecration at the Last Supper and on every time this Act has been repeated.
- In every consecrated Host – past, present or future.
- In reparation for every offense throughout time that Jesus will receive in the Holy Eucharist.
- In the teaching that Jesus gave the Apostles, that they must do what He has done.
- In the power that Jesus gave to the Apostles and to every priest to consecrate the bread into His Body and the wine into His Blood.
- In the first Act of Jesus after He received Himself when He multiplied Himself for as many creatures that can exist in the world so that each soul should have a Life of Jesus for herself.



We have also included a beautiful prayer from Our Lady. She told Luisa that Our Lord cannot resist anyone who approaches Him dressed in His Wounds.

***Prayer when approaching Communion (or it can be prayed afterward):**

O, my Jesus, I crown my head with Your Thorns
I bead my eyes with Your Tears
I impregnate my tongue with Your Bitterness
I adorn my soul with Your Blood
I dress my body with Your Wounds
I nail my hands and feet with Your Nails
I pierce my heart with Your Lance
And, as another Christ, I present myself
Before Your most supreme Majesty and ask
That through the offering of this Holy Communion
You may grant the Greatest of Graces
THAT YOUR KINGDOM COME, THAT YOUR
WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS DONE IN HEAVEN
BY ALL SOULS, MOST ESPECIALLY BY MINE.
